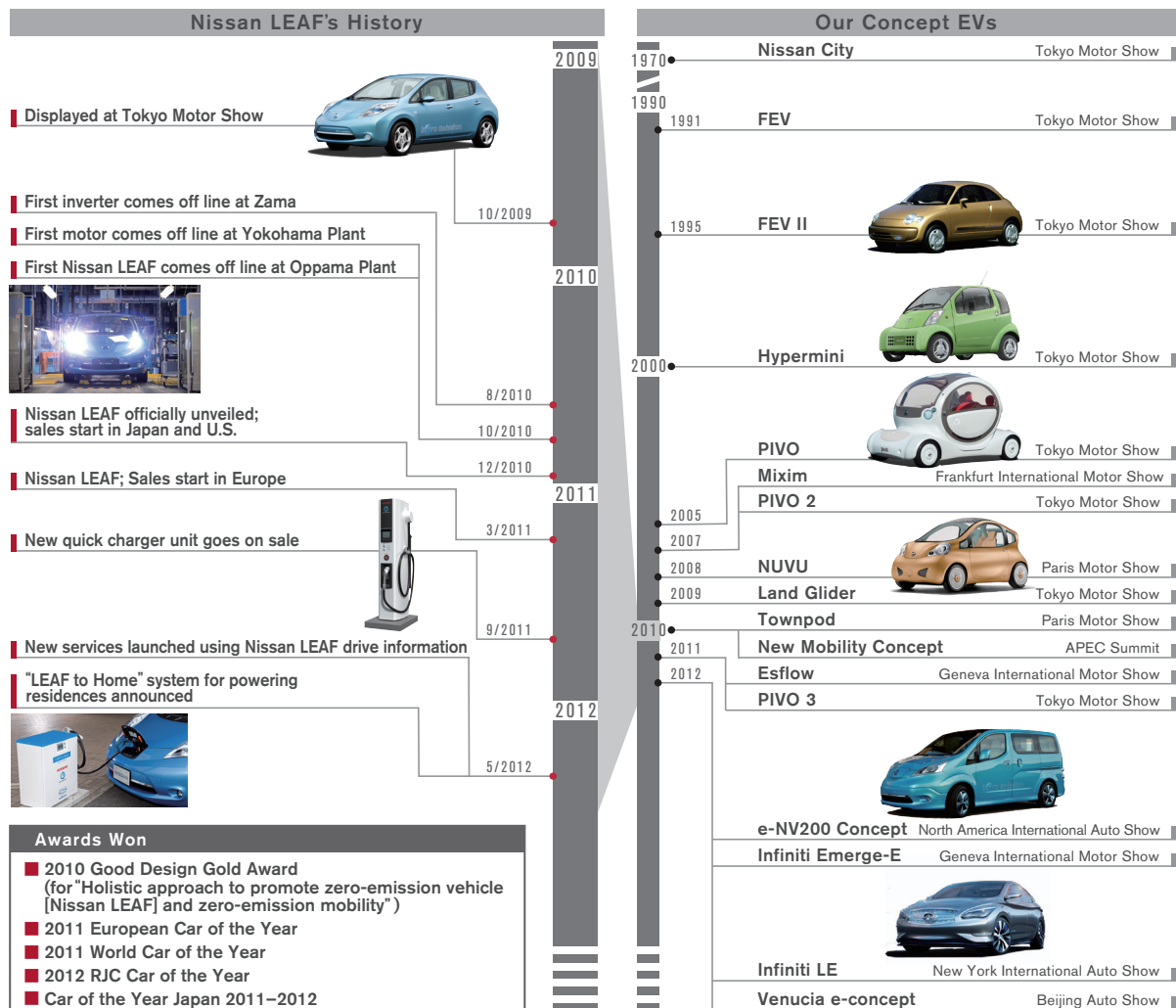


Nissan's Electric Vehicle History

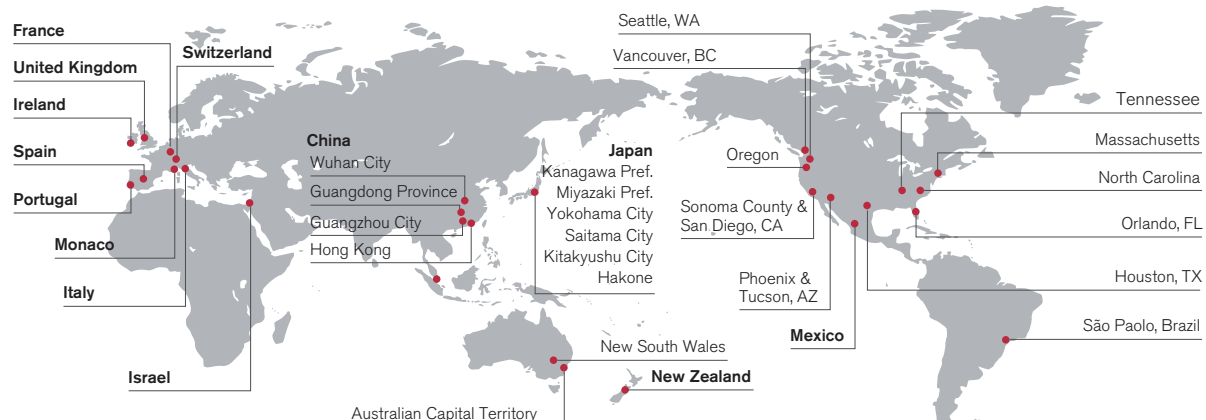
